- Involving 8,200 individuals
- Actions date back to 1954,
but most (10,700) in last 10 years

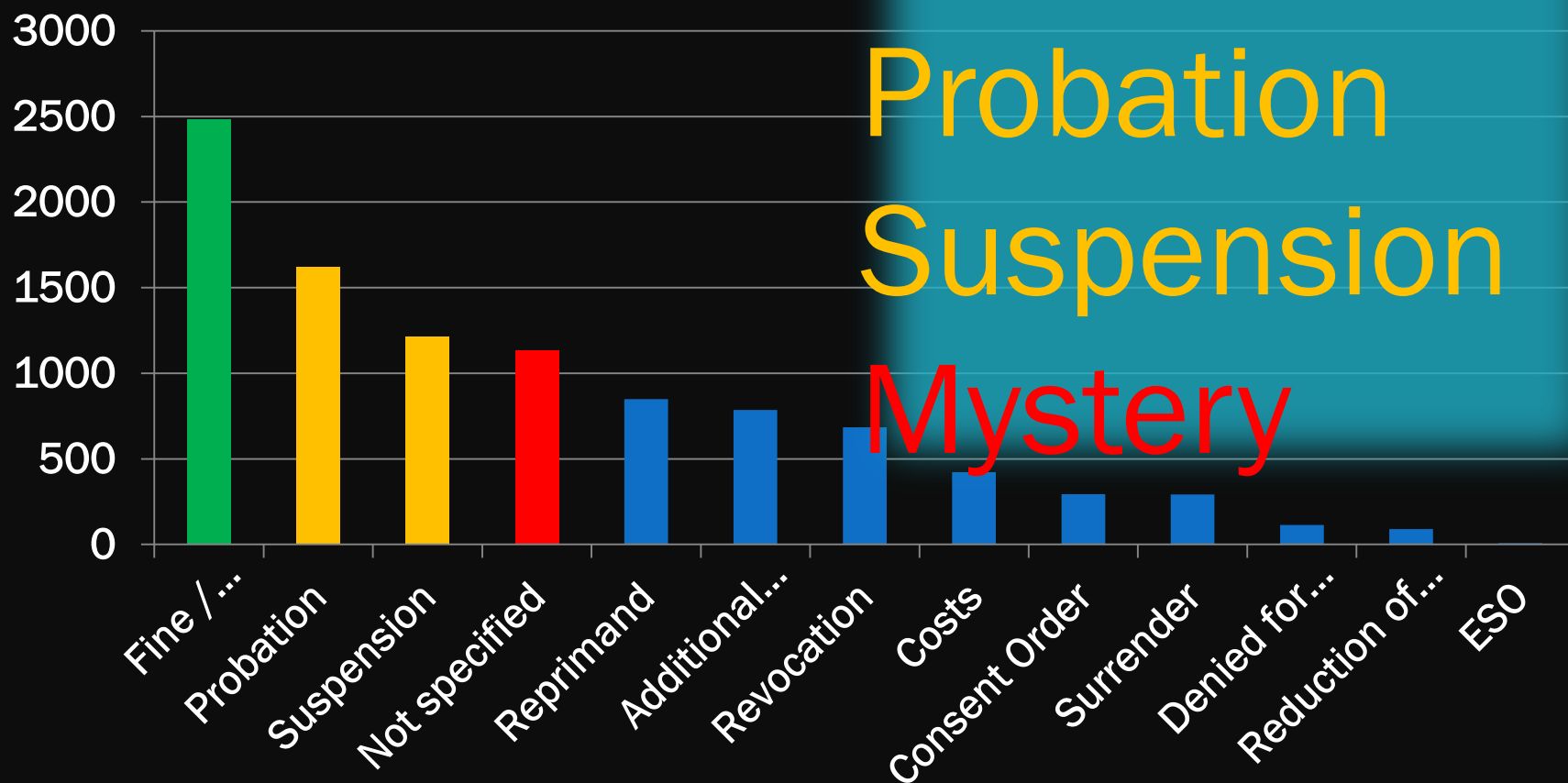

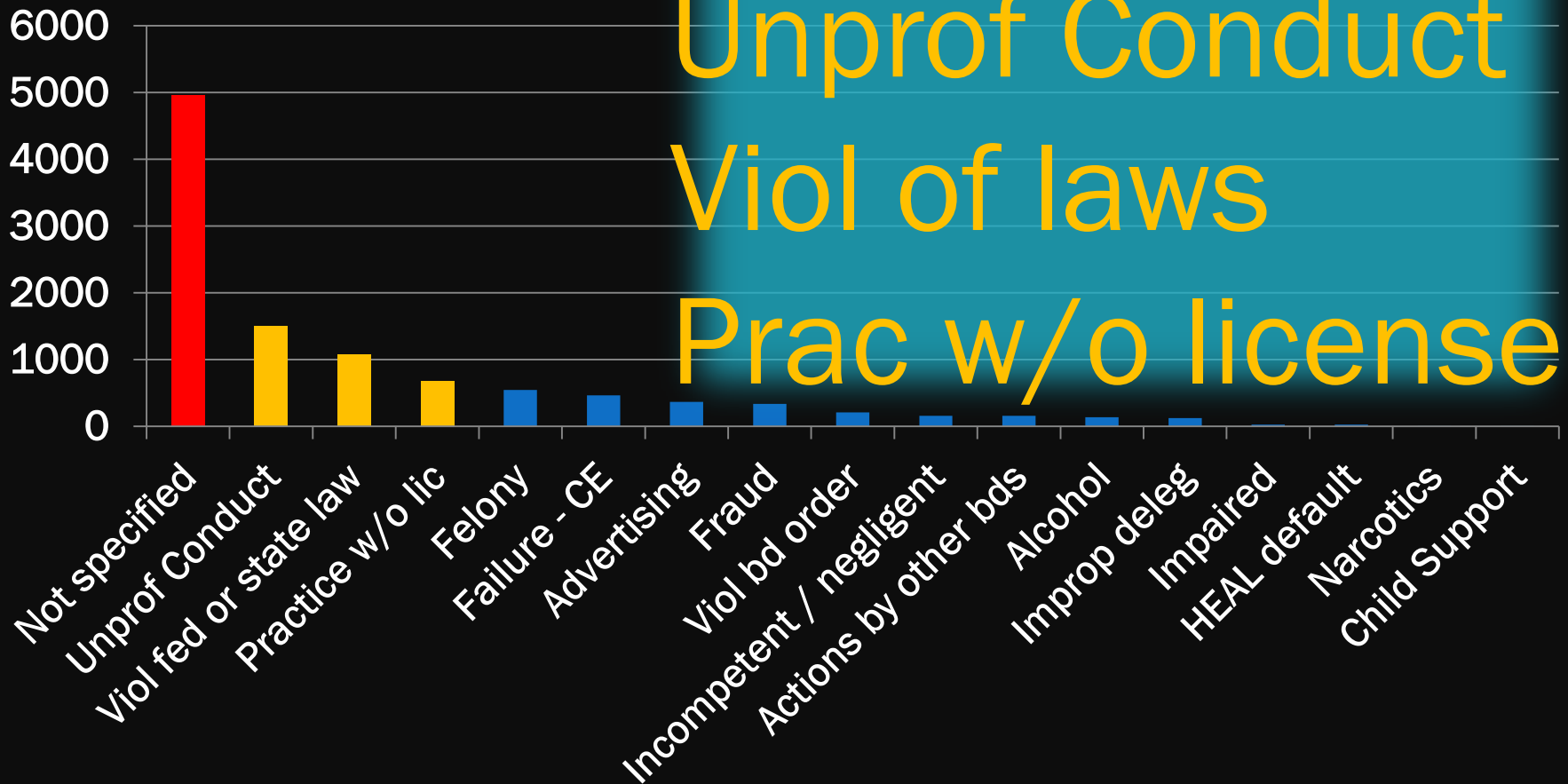

Trends in Discipline

Increasing: disciplinary sanctions

- Fines, penalties, recovery of costs
- Stayed suspensions
- Educational and testing
- Emergency Suspension Orders

Trends in Discipline

Increasing: Grounds for violations...
(doubled in 10 yrs)

- Unclassified (this is not helpful!)
- Felony
- Failure to comply with CE
- Violation of board orders
- Practice w/o license
