Raising dues for the first time in five years

WHEREAS, the services of the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards continue to expand in support of our mission to protect the public and serve our member boards by promoting excellence in chiropractic regulation; and

WHEREAS, the costs of these services continue to increase; and

WHEREAS, member dues compose approximately 6% of the Federation's budget, with the balance supplied by generous operations support from other organizations and by earned income through program services; and

WHEREAS, the dues of the FCLB were last raised in 1994, effective in January 1995, and are still significantly less than other federations, now therefore be it

RESOLVED,

That the Federation raise its dues as follows, effective in January 2000:
