**Adopting the Model Ethics Code as an official FCLB Publication
for Voluntary Adoption or Adaptation
by the Chiropractic Regulatory Boards**

WHEREAS, the ethical conduct of chiropractic and public board members in chiropractic regulation is of critical importance to the effectiveness of professional regulation; and

WHEREAS, the FCLB volunteered to develop such a Code after participating in a leadership development seminar for regulated professions represented at the July 1998 meeting of the Federation of Associations of Regulatory Boards; and

WHEREAS, the draft document was circulated for comment at both the FCLB regional district meetings in the fall of 1998 and the FARB Forum in February 1999; and

WHEREAS, the body of the document is now complete, with only reference appendices in process; and

WHEREAS, the adoption or adaptation of the document for use by individual member boards is strictly voluntary, now therefore be it

RESOLVED,

That the Federation adopt the *Model Code of Ethics for Members of Regulatory Boards* as an official publication of the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards.
