

Resolution #2-04

To increase the member dues by \$100 per category in 2005

WHEREAS, the members of the Federation last voted to raise the member dues in 1999; and

WHEREAS, operating costs continue to increase with inflation and as more services are provided to our member boards; and

WHEREAS, the current dues represent approximately 8% of the Federation's budget; and

WHEREAS, the current dues structure is based upon the number of active licenses (with active licenses defined as those for which a renewal fee has been paid in the past two years, including resident and non-resident licenses) as follows:

01 - 49 active licenses .	\$225	500 - 999	\$525	2000 - 3999	\$850
50 - 199	\$400	1000 - 1499	\$625	4000+	\$950
200 - 499	\$475	1500 - 1999	\$750		

and,

WHEREAS, the bylaws of the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards address the requirements for determining and approving the dues structure as follows:

Article X. Revenues and Dues

Section 2. Dues

Annual dues for Honorary Fellows shall be set by the Board of Directors. Annual dues for member chiropractic boards shall be determined by the Board of Directors and approved by a majority vote of the member chiropractic boards. Any member chiropractic board whose dues are in default at the time of the annual business meeting shall be ineligible to vote.

and,

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2004, the FCLB Board of Directors has approved a \$100 increase per category effective for the calendar year 2005, pending approval by the member boards; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Federation increase member dues by \$100 per category, effective January 1, 2005.
