On May 1, the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards hosted its 94th Annual Meeting via Zoom and Livestream.

The meeting focused on updating FCLB stakeholders on current projects and financial status as well as holding elections and voting on adoption of proposed resolutions.

Prior to the meeting, Dr. Karlos Boghosian (CT) presented awards to individuals and organizations whose leadership, commitment to public protection, and unwavering dedication to chiropractic regulation stood out in a year of challenges and rapid changes. Honorees were recognized for their willingness to go above and beyond to fulfill the mission of the FCLB.

FCLB Directors hosted caucuses the morning of the meeting to elect representatives for open seats in the upcoming term. District V elected a Director and Alternate Director for a full term. 

CIN-BAD

Chiropractic Information Network -
Board Action Databank

CIN-BAD has launched the Automatic Notification System (ANS) for member boards and subscribers. These monthly updates includes lists of current actions and reports to the system so regulatory and credentialing agencies know when their licensees have been disciplined. ANS is another important step in patient safety and licensee oversight.

Please note that a growing number of boards are not up-to-date on their reporting. While FCLB staff does work to track down and enter all actions, **board omissions may leave patients unprotected.**

CCCA

Certified Chiropractic Clinical Assistants

Another service available to member boards is the Certified Chiropractic Clinical Assistant (CCCA) program. As more boards look at patient safety and chiropractic assistants, the need for uniform standards is increasing. Like all of our programs and services, the CCCA is designed so you don't have to reinvent the wheel. If you are considering language to regulate chiropractic assistants, please contact us to learn how this program might help your board.

PACE

Providers of Approved Continuing Education

The FCLB Board of Directors have approved changes to the governing documents for Providers of Approved Continuing Education – Chiropractic (PACE). These revisions include modifying the current amendment procedures, granting the PACE Chair in consultation with the FCLB Executive Director emergency authority to suspend non-compliant providers, and stronger distance learning criteria in keeping with current licensing board standards.

As the PACE program continues to grow, remember that it can offer a great service to your board - providing oversight your volunteers and staff may not have the time for as well as acting as a "neighborhood watch" for continuing education compliance.

CURRENT FCLB PROJECTS

- **Telehealth Committee:** Tasked with exploring how telehealth could be applied to chiropractic care and what regulatory structures might be needed to ensure patient safety, this committee has begun discussing ways to encourage best practices.
- **Diversity and Inclusion Committee:** The purpose of this committee is to raise awareness about FCLB's commitment to diversity and inclusion in chiropractic regulation, develop strategies to increase diversity in those involved with chiropractic regulation and the FCLB, increase interest amongst chiropractic students with diverse backgrounds to get involved in chiropractic regulation, and develop strategies for training/communication material pertaining to diversity in the regulatory industry.
- **Specialty Council Task Force:** Currently, licensing boards lack universal minimum standards of education and oversight for specialty certification. This task force works to assess current models and provide framework or guidance for licensing boards in approving or recognizing specialty certifications. We welcome input on this developing project.
